Code of Conduct:

The objective of our 2016 program is to promote a fun and enriching friendship experience among all of our Blue Roses Girls. In order to create and maintain this environment, the Board of Directors and all mentors and volunteers of Blue Roses Girls will use praise and positive reinforcement as an effective way of managing our Blue Roses Girls at our events. We have listed below our acceptable behaviors at our events:

- Friendliness to all Blue Roses Girls
- Being Respectful to all adults at the events
- Listening and following directions calmly
- Using appropriate language when talking to everyone
- Staying within the designated areas of the event and adhering to all safety rules as outlined

Please review the above points with your Blue Roses Girl each time you plan to attend our events.

Blue Roses Girls who have demonstrated good character and independence may be dropped off at our events.

The Board of Blue Roses Girls reserves the right to request adult supervision for your daughter(s) for the duration of the event if we feel it would benefit the whole group. Girls who are new to the group need an adult guardian present until a comfort level with the group and mentors is established.

Consequences of actions should this Code of Conduct be violated while attending Blue Roses Girls Events:

- Initially, a quiet verbal reprimand will be given by a mentor or adult supervisor
- If the behavior reoccurs, a verbal warning will be given to the Blue Roses Girl and a phone call will be made to the parent or guardian
- If the behavior continues, a written incident report will be given to the parent or guardian.
- If the offense is dire, which includes but is not limited to fighting, hitting, throwing items, theft, vandalism, inappropriate language, pushing, screaming, bullying, teasing, laughing or making fun of other girls, or any other behavior deemed inappropriate to the occasion, the Blue Roses Girl will be immediately dismissed from the current program and may be prohibited from attending any other programs
- The Board of Directors will refer the parents to a certified Behavioral Analyst to help remediate the situation. The Board of Directors will consult with the Behavioral Professional and will seek their guidance to see if the Blue Roses Girl can be admitted back into the program with additional support.
- The Board of Directors reserves the right to bypass all the other steps listed above and the final decision to dismiss a participant from the program will be made by the Board of Directors taking into account all the circumstances.
- If the behavior continues beyond the written warning and referral, the Blue Roses Girl will be asked to leave the remainder of the program with no refund of already collected fees.
